I address this letter to you in your capacity as the Chief Executive Officer of Culver City Forward.

I request that Culver City Forward provide me with a copy of: (1) its exemption application; and (2) each of its annual returns.

According to the IRS, "An exempt organization must make available for public inspection its exemption application. ... In addition, an exempt organization must make available for public inspection and copying its annual return." (Emphasis added.) Penalties may apply to "responsible persons" at tax-exempt organizations that fail to comply.

This request covers Culver City Forward from the date of its inception on March 1, 2019, regardless of the corporation's prior history with Michael D. Hackman and Hackman Capital Partners, LLC.
