Proceedings: (In Chambers) Order re: Scheduling Conference

The parties appeared for a scheduling conference on January 28, 2008. At the conference, the parties agreed to meet and confer in an attempt to voluntarily resolve Plaintiff's Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") claim. If Plaintiff's FOIA claim is not voluntarily resolved, the government is **ORDERED** to file a *Vaughn* index, by February 28, 2008, with respect to the documents still in dispute. If all of the document disputes are resolved, the parties are **ORDERED** to file a joint brief, by no later than February 28, 2008, notifying the court that the FOIA claim is resolved and no *Vaughn* index is necessary.

With respect to Plaintiff's Administrative Procedure Act ("APA") claim, we hereby stay discovery with respect to this claim for 60 days hereof. The government is *strongly* urged that, if Defendant is going to act on Plaintiff's petition for rulemaking, it do so within that time. The parties are **ORDERED** to file a joint status report within **sixty** (**60**) **days** hereof, or earlier if a decision is made, on the status of Plaintiff's petition for rulemaking and his APA claim.
